

Duncan does it again and again

CURRENT world champion and Coffs Harbour waveski surfing legend Rees Duncan has added another title to his already impressive list of achievements.

Competing at the Australian Waveski Surfing Titles at Wollongong, Duncan grabbed his eighth Australian Open Title, equalling the number of titles won by fellow waveski legend, John Christensen.

Held in the waters of Sandon Point and East Corrimal, Duncan showed that he was clearly the best of a sensational field every time he took on the three to six foot conditions that were on offer.

As one of six of the world's top 10 waveski surfers that were the national championships, Duncan knew that he had a tough task ahead of him if he was going to win the historic title but he was more than up to the challenge.

Winning his way through to the final, Duncan became involved in a nail biter of a man-on-man final against local surfer Blair Moore from Woonoona.

As the local boy, Moore was the favourite to win the event not only among the experts but among the local crowd watching on.

But you should never discount a champion and the Coffs Harbour star showed what he was made of to overcome his more fancied opponent.

To make the week even better for Duncan, he also won the seniors division at the event.

This made the champ the only person in the history of Australian waveski surfing to win both the open and seniors divisions twice.
